What kind exactly is an ephemeral pond? Join us to find out!

Kids will each get to “catch” their prey along the way and determine if, as a predator of choice, they’ve eaten enough to survive. Enjoy all nature has to offer on 70 acres at 10,200 feet.

Staff will be providing guided tours of the property on the hour between 10am – 3pm. In addition to learning about ecology and our namesake beavers, you can expect to visit the barn and learn about alpacas, llamas, goats, and chickens. You can also visit the greenhouse and learn how to keep a year round garden. Visitors will also learn about five types of renewable energy and ways to make forests healthier.
